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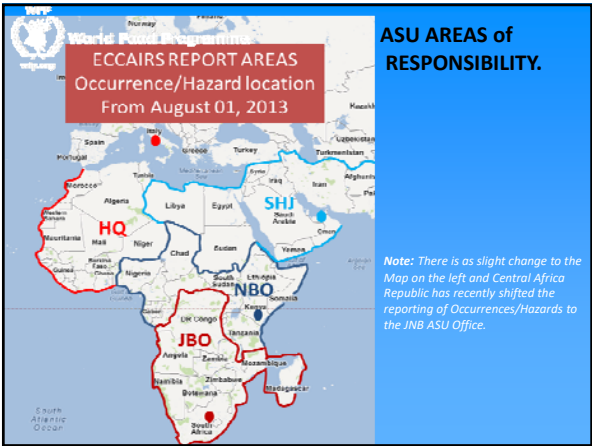

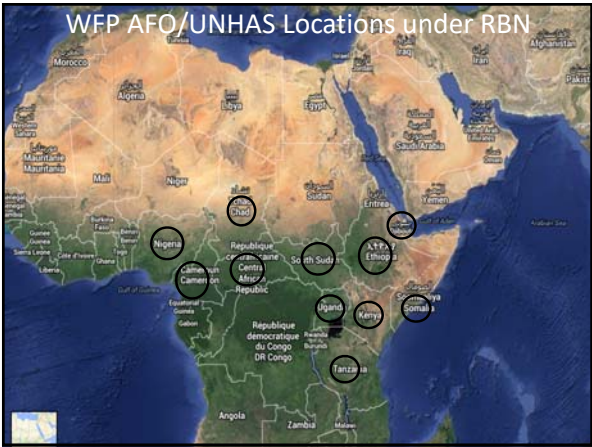


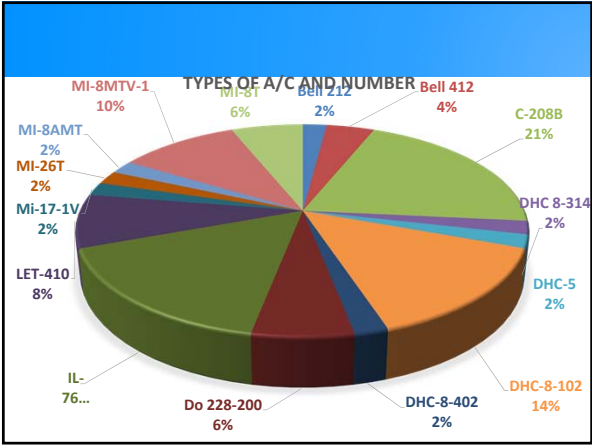
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NBO ASU:

- ASU Regional office at Nairobi is in charge of an area comprising 17 countries.
- 54 Aircraft operate on behalf of WFP in the Region.
- It represents 66 % (2/3) of WFP chartered aircraft fleet.

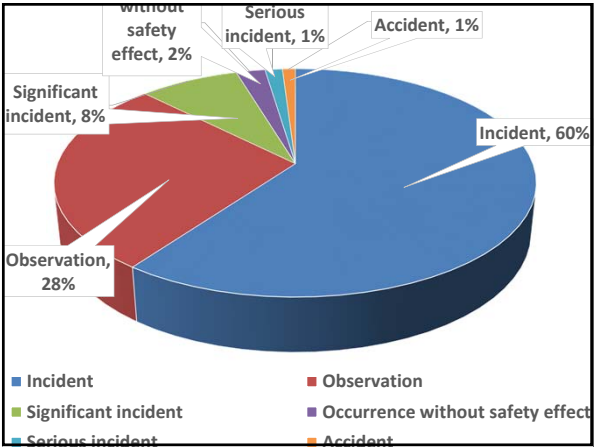


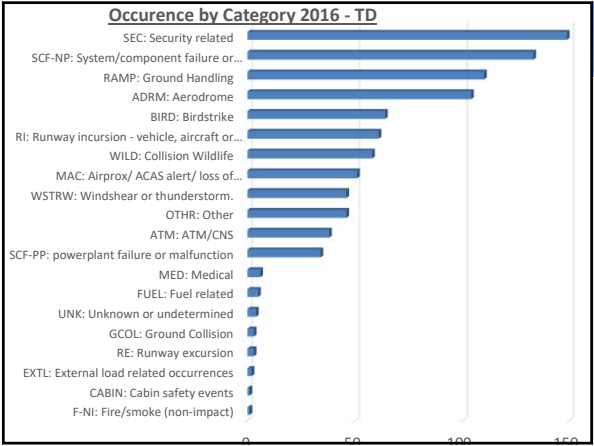


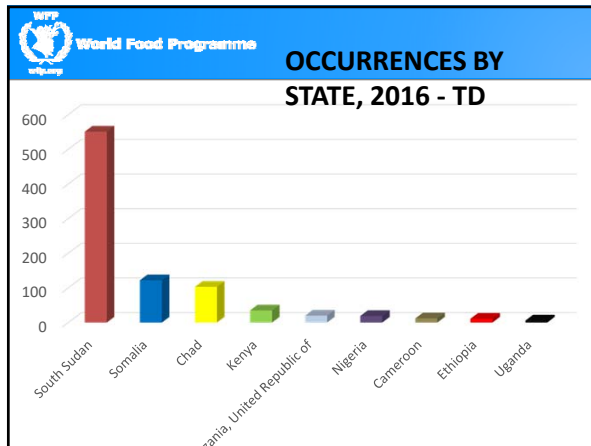




OCCURRENCES & HAZARD STATISTICS





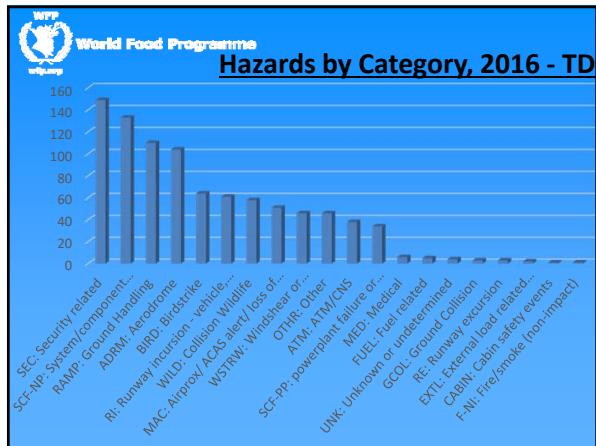




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Observations:

- The main categories of occurrences in 2016: Security issues, System Component Failures- NP, Ramp, Aerodrome issues, Bird are the highest in number.





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MAIN RISKS

- MAC/Airprox: improved coordination and processes with airspace stakeholders such as Air Operators, CAAs, ICAO, IATA, DFS, and WFP aviation operations.
- AVSEC: ASU has interacted with WFP Aviation and provided updates on all security related events in the operation to WFP aviation and trained the WFP AVSEC officer on the use & processing of AVSEC reports using ECCAIRS.
- Runway Incursion: Focal point functions.
