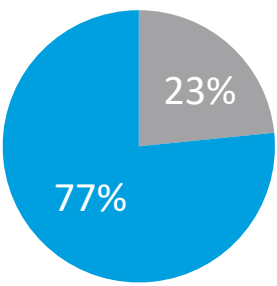
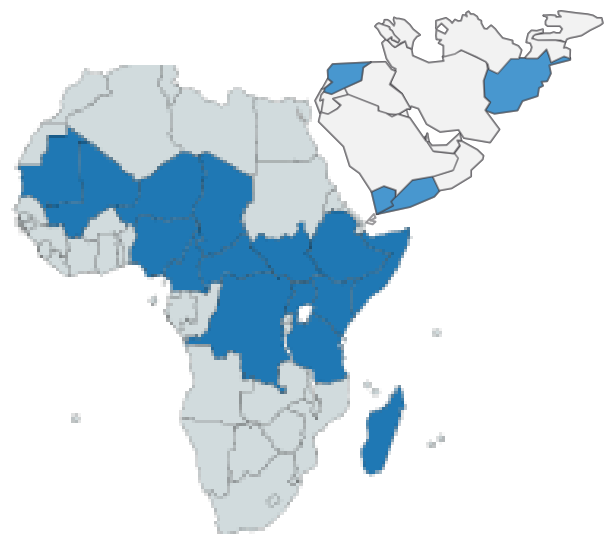


Humanitarian Aviation fleet powered by P&WC

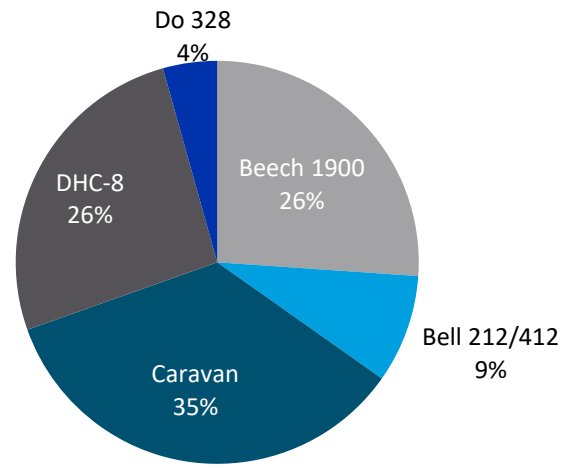
