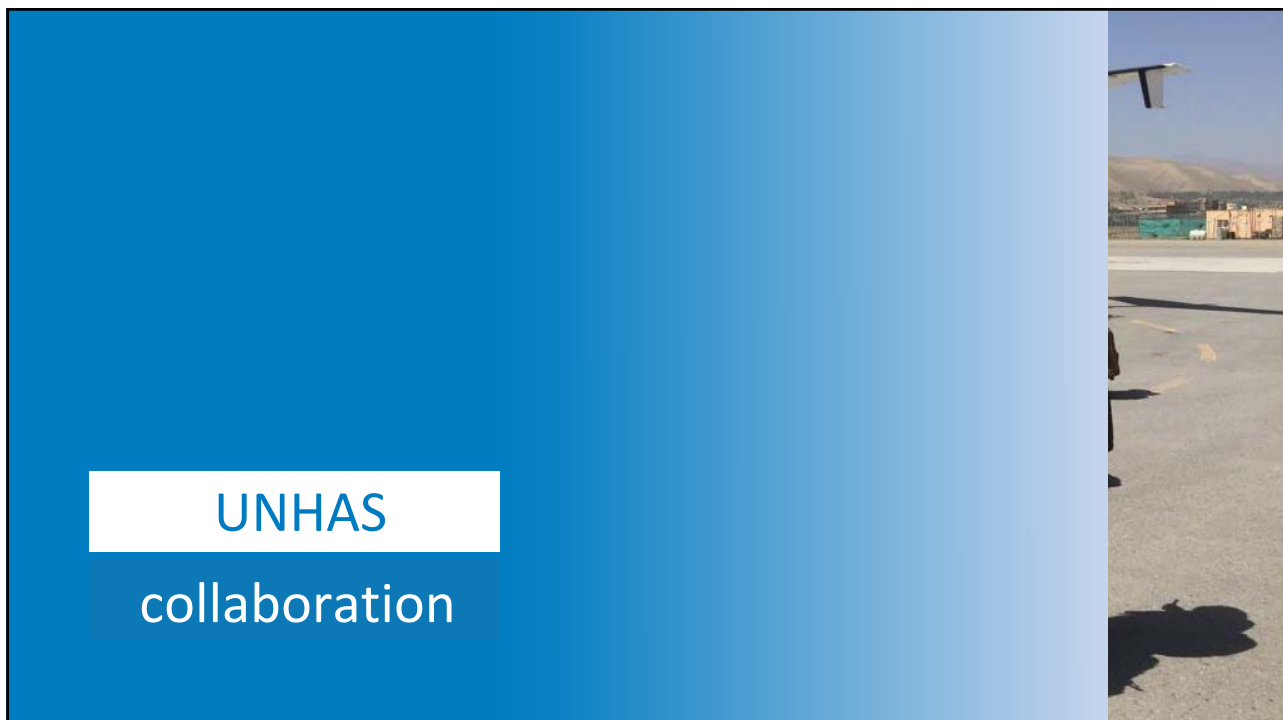
MAP OF ROUTES – GLOBAL PASSENGER AIR SERVICE



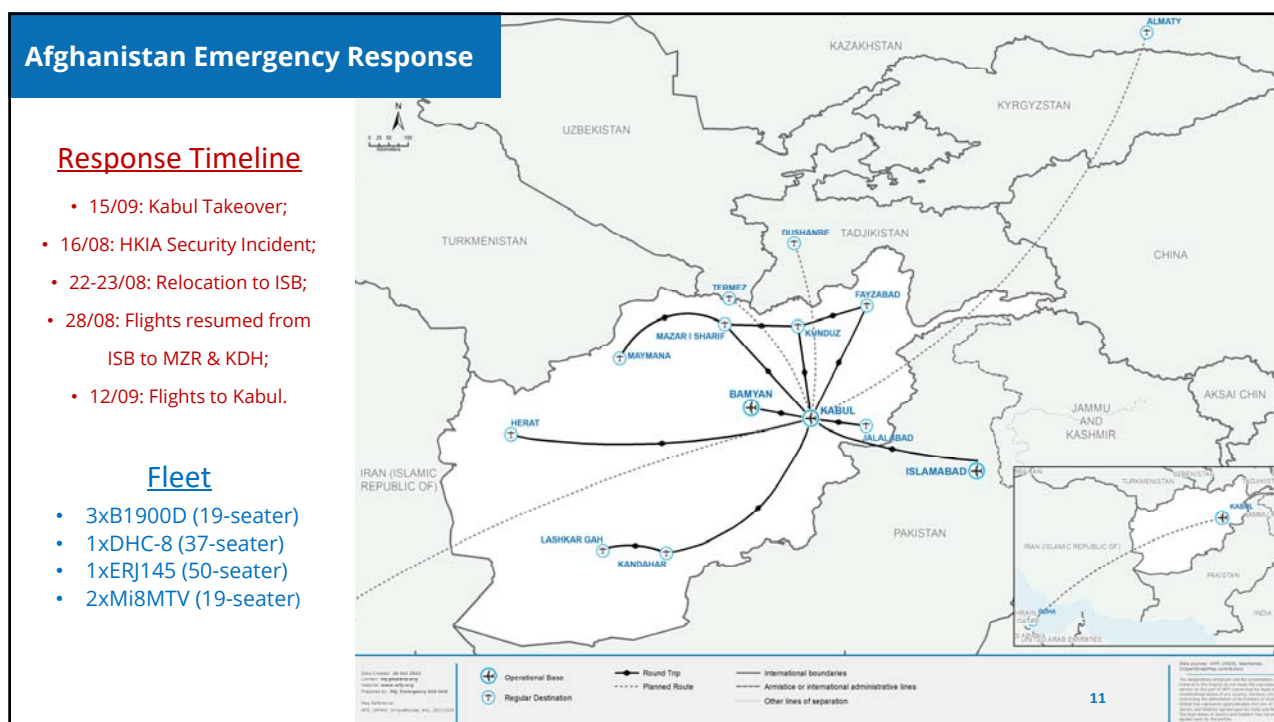

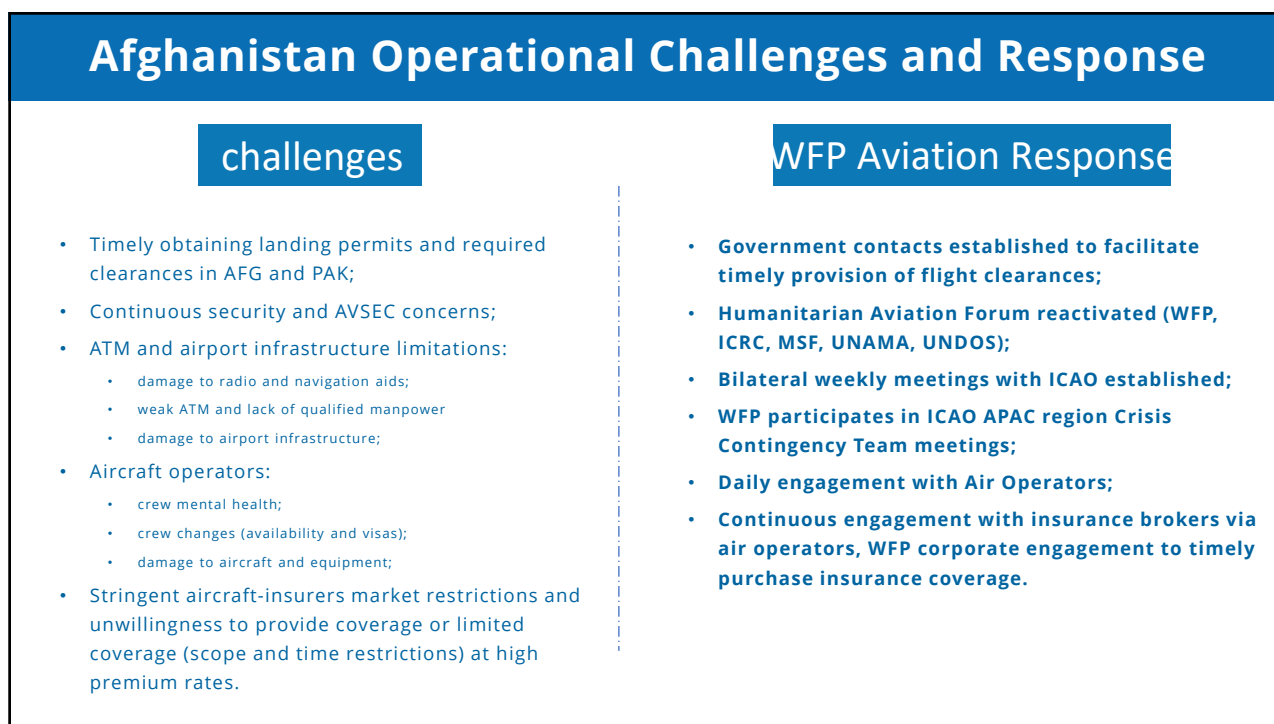

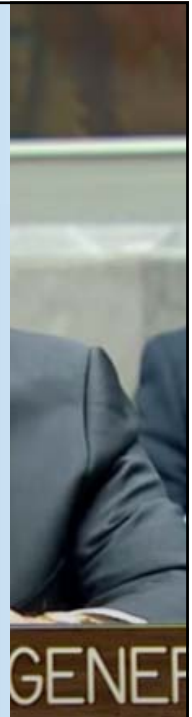

13 September 2021

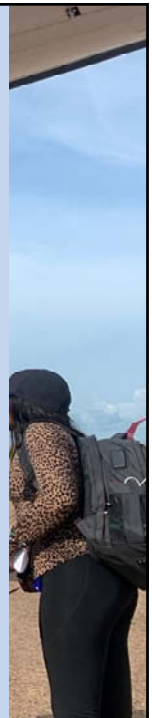
