- ✓ **Special technical assistance programmes**, as well as **innovative** and **technology solutions**

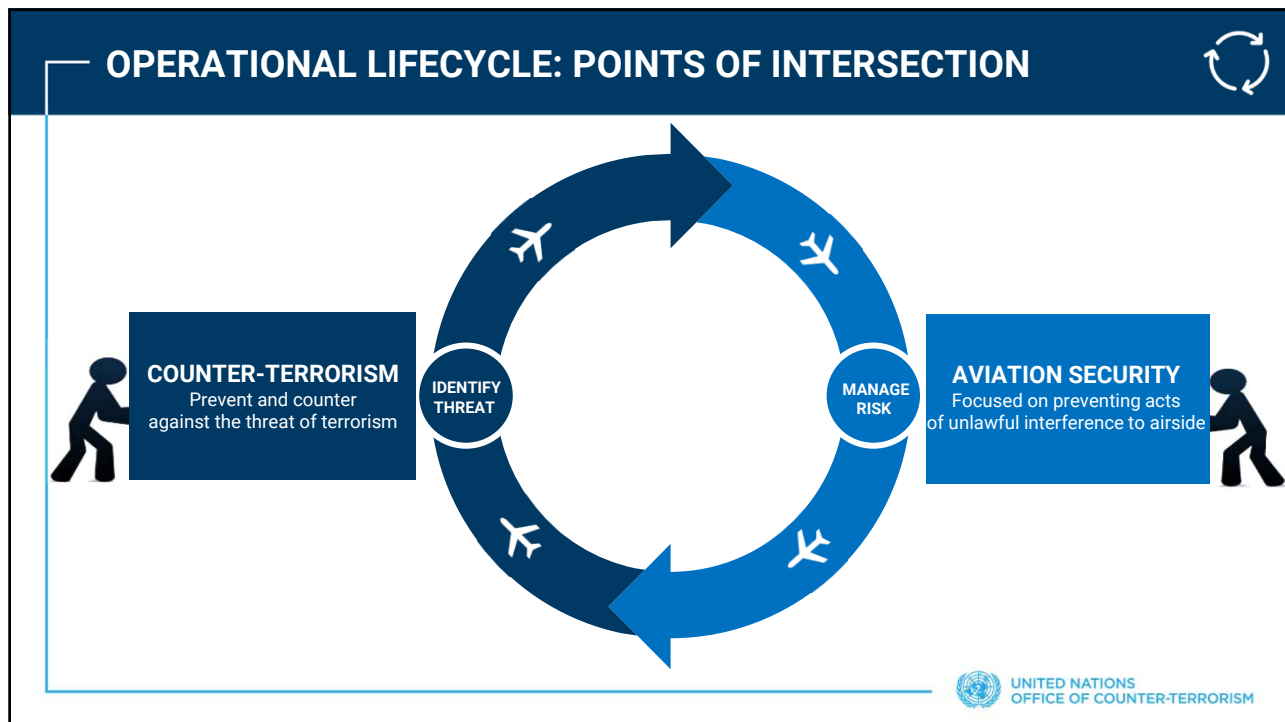

Programme Champion

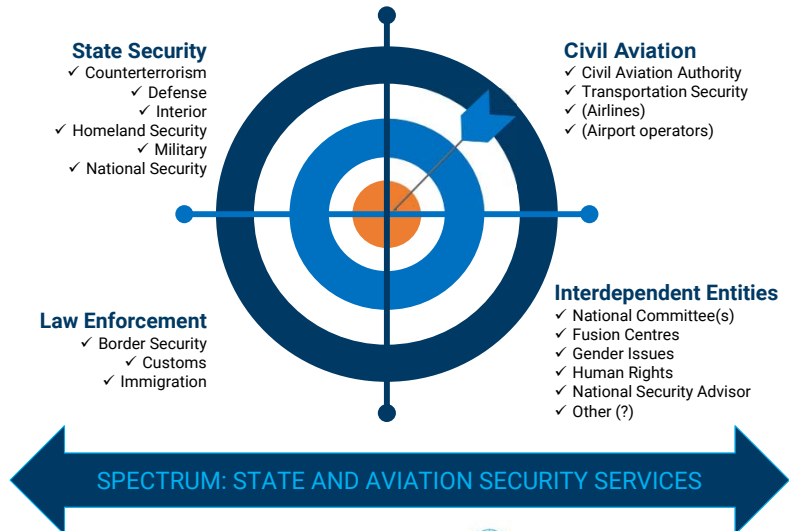
Senior-level executive with necessary political capital to mobilize support and resources absolutely critical to achieve Programme outcomes.

Executives Review Board

Highest-ranking executive from each national agency with a mandate relevant to interagency coordination. Responsible for approving the new coordination and carrying out implementation.

Integrated Project Team

Operational-level personnel with day-to-day duties for managing terrorist threats and risks to civil aviation.

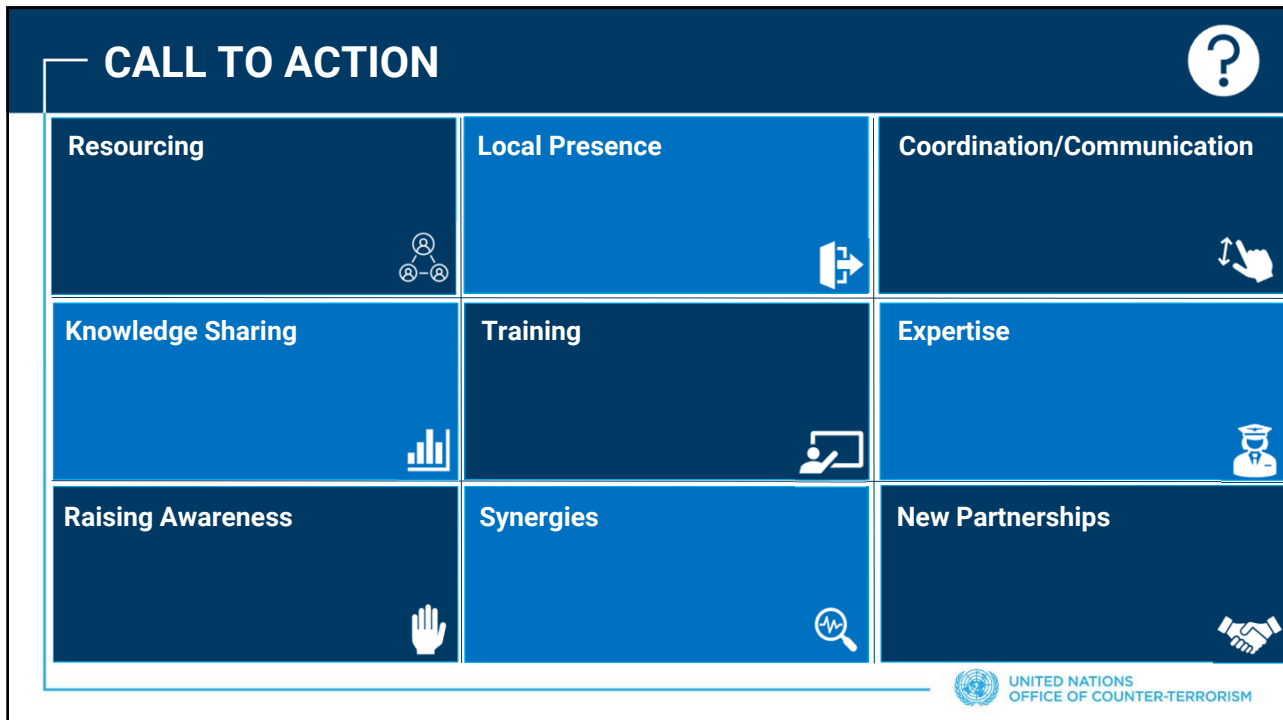
ESTABLISHED TRUST ACROSS STATE SECURITY AND AVIATION SECURITY SERVICES

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PROGRAMME LIFECYCLE



PHASE 1 | INITIAL ENGAGEMENT

Establish preliminary picture
of the beneficiary Member State

3-4 Months



PHASE 2 | NEEDS EVALUATION

Develop understanding of current operating environment,
potential impacts to future cooperation, and
requirements to support interagency cooperation
on threat information relevant to aviation security

2-3 Months



PHASE 4 | OPERATIONAL SUPPORT

Institutionalize knowledge into practice

1-3 Months



PHASE 3 | TRAINING & TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Sequenced training and technical assistance activities
delivered on-site and virtually to Integrated Project Team (IPT)
on a part-time basis

3-4 Months



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
