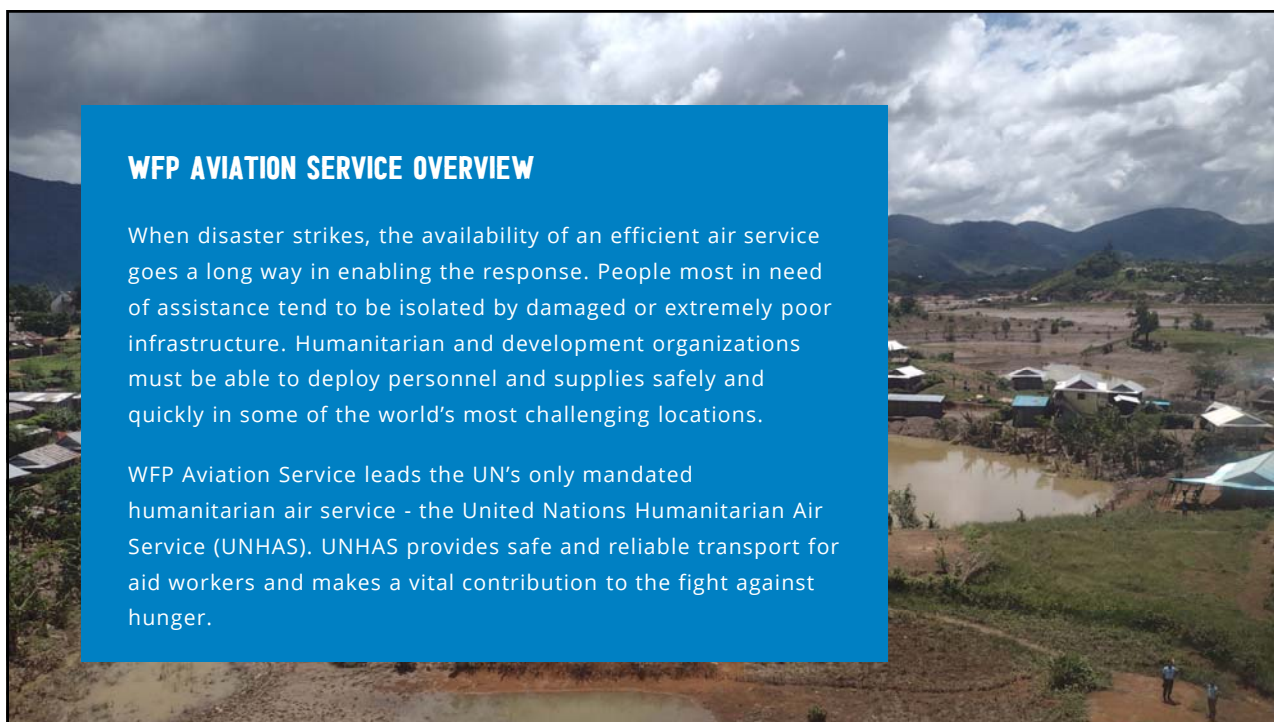

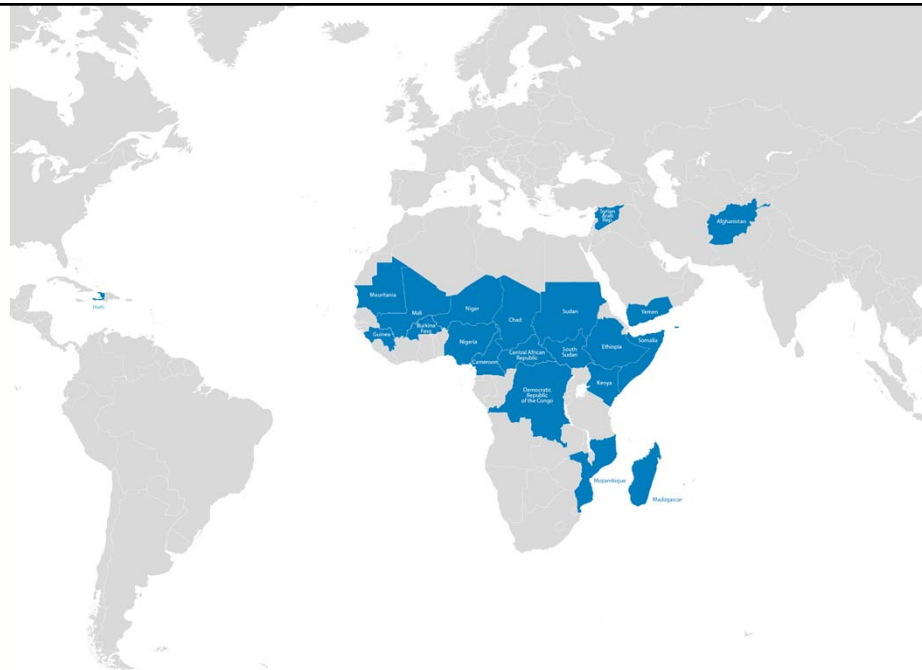

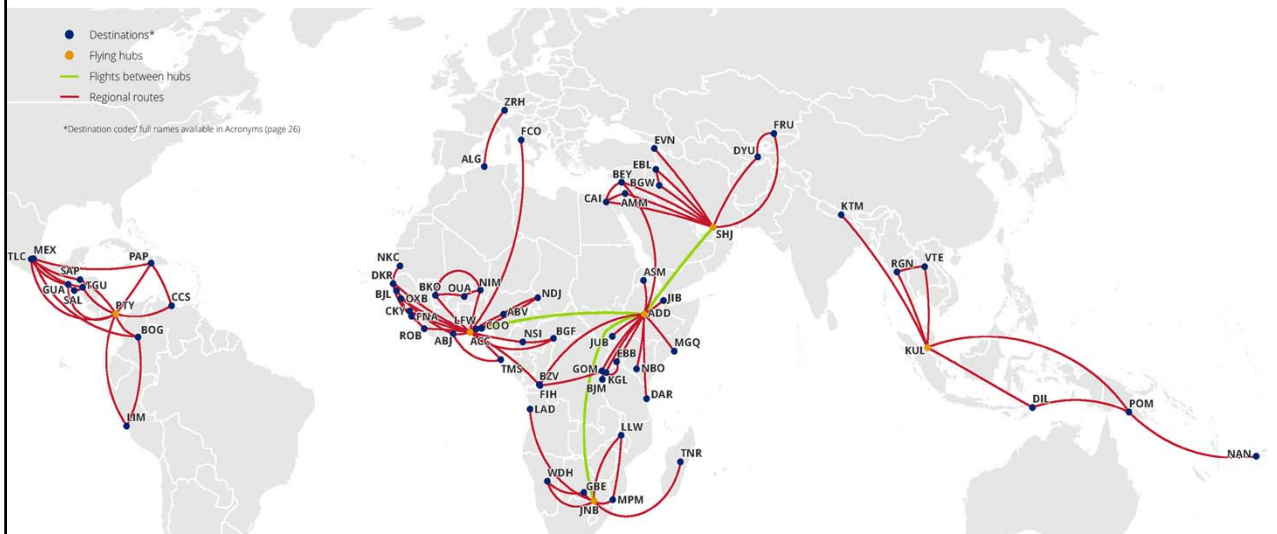
UNHAS provides:

Destinations served through the Global Passengers Air Service - COVID-19 response



- WFP performed over 1,500 passenger flights worldwide, as part of the global response to COVID-19.
- 67 of these flights reached destinations in Latin America such as Bogota, Caracas, Guatemala, Lima, among others, when commercial options were unavailable and WFP was the only solution for humanitarian aid in the region.

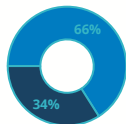

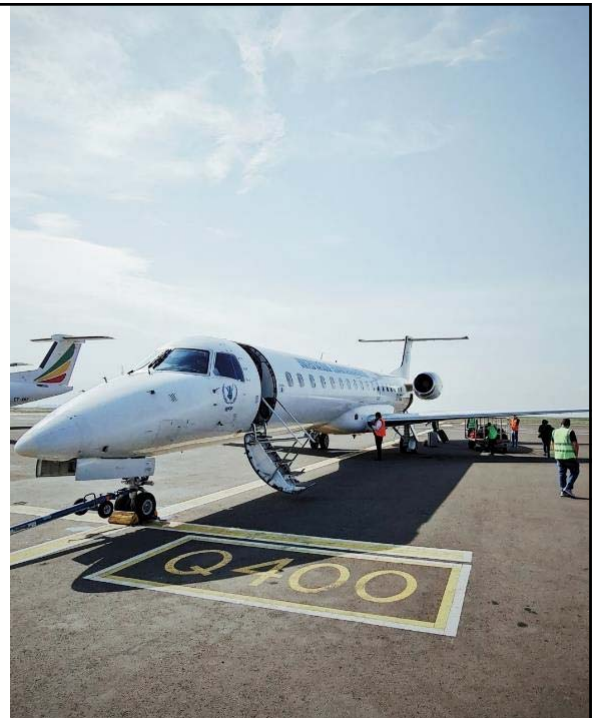

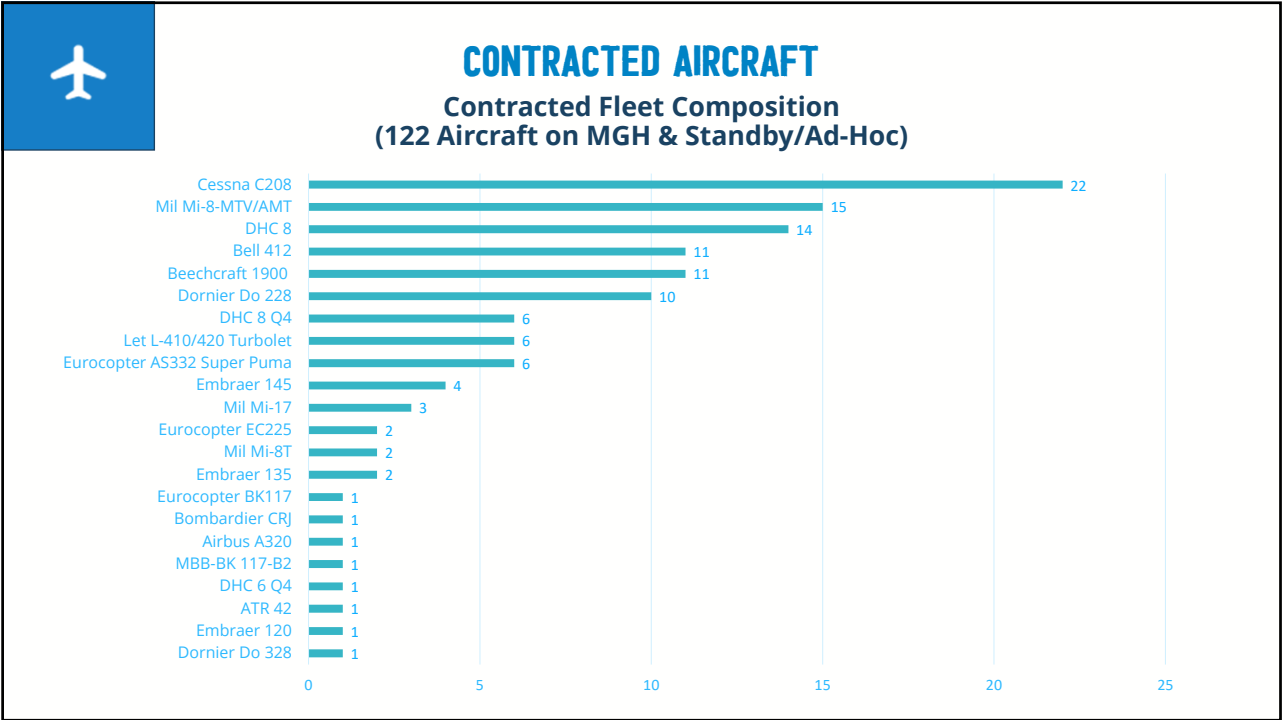

AIRDROPS

The cargo air-dropped in 2021 in South Sudan was equal to **25,000 MT** corresponding to about a thousand drops, a slight decrease compared to 29,000 MT air-dropped in 2020 (mainly due to borders closure during COVID-19 peak, especially in Juba and Bor, the primary dispatch hubs for food to Jonglei State), while **the number of drop zones increased with 61 in 2021** compared to 51 in 2020, showing a wider geographical reach.

In 2022, cargo airdrops continued until October with a total of **11,400 MT** air-dropped in **43 drop zones**.

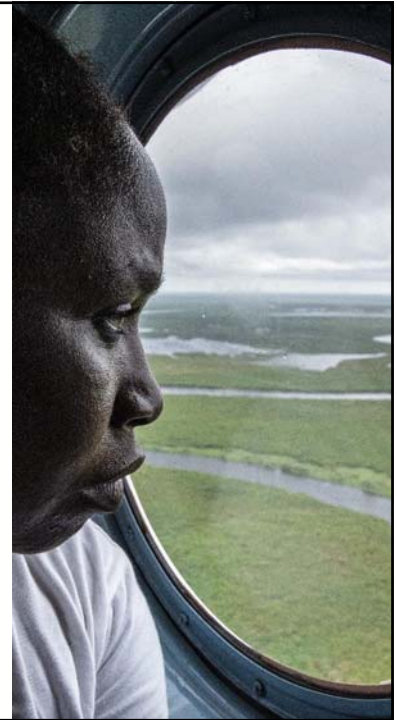
WFP AVIATION ENVIRONMENTAL AND SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAMME

Launched in 2021 to operationalize WFP's commitment to **environmental improvement and reduction of carbon footprint**.

Key achievements to date:

- **Aircraft CO2 emission calculation methodology** with environmental KPIs established
- **Environmental component** integrated into contracting and procurement processes, donor proposals and reports
- **2-phase case study** conducted to assess operational opportunities to minimize aircraft fuel usage and emissions as defined by ICAO:
 - ✓ **Decrease of fuel consumed by 2%** when implementing ICAO technical measures by selected operators on 50% of WFP fleet
 - ✓ **Potential 1 million US\$ per year net savings** of fuel purchased if same measures maintained for all aircraft
 - ✓ **Environmental Management System (EMS)** being implemented as necessary requirement by all WFP-contracted air operators
 - ✓ **Extended Emissions Reduction Actions Checklist** developed by WFP Aviation will be implemented by all contracted air operators

First **Humanitarian Aviation Environmental Summit** held in March 2022.
