Coordination on ATS impact

- Proactive (before a contingency event could be expected)
 - What measures might be in place,- Attempt to be predictive with continued situational awareness.
- During the contingency (what to expect for better airline operational planning)
 - Ex. NOTAMs that were changed last minute without previous information. Or outage.
- Explore different options in coordination with stakeholders (airlines and others) when a contingency is affecting the normal operation.
 - ATM or CNS outage; how to avoid the restriction, is it affecting the whole airspace or just a portion of it, etc..

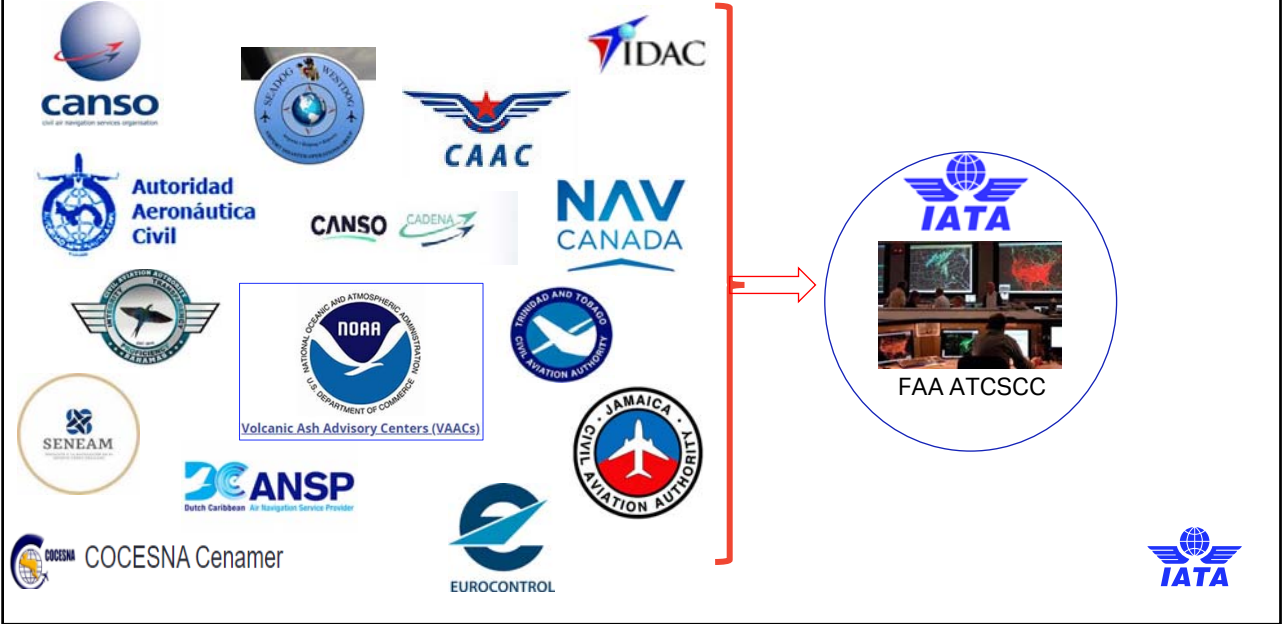
Advancing communication via Contingency Coordination Team (CCT)

- Communication - FAA Facilities coordinated every 2 hr- Collaboration with Industry / Airlines
- IATA Tactical Operational Portal (ITOP) stakeholders' outreach as a mechanism
- Collaborative information exchange is invaluable during such events Lessons learned to enhance the process is ongoing



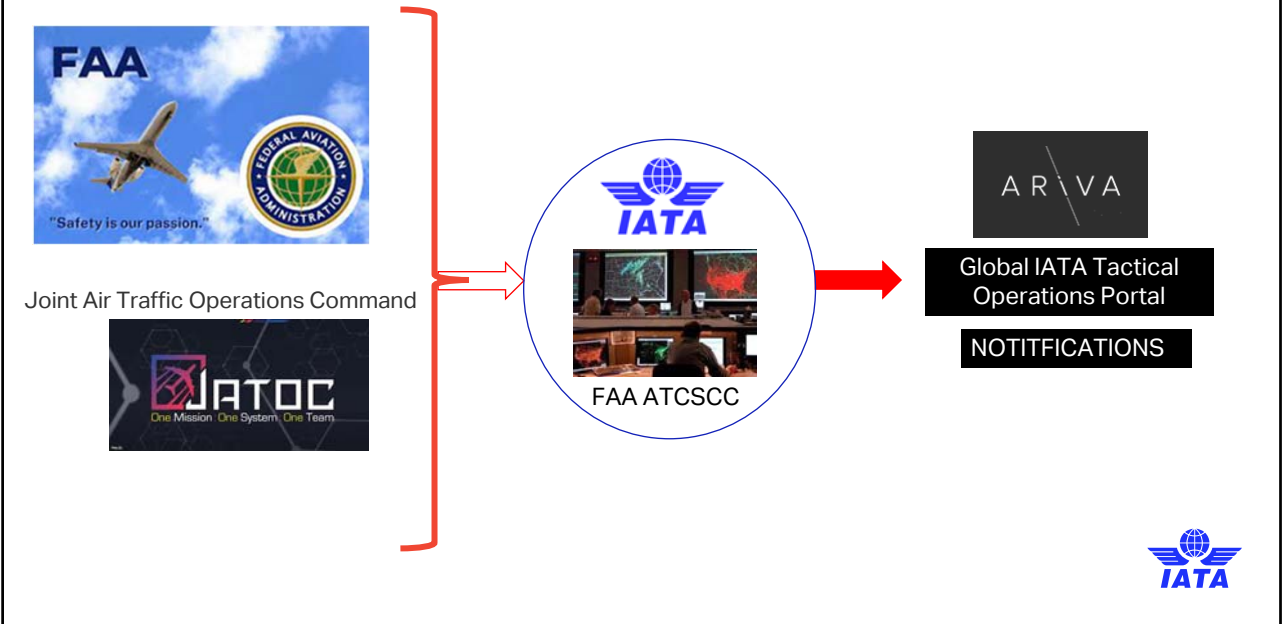
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IATA Liaison Desk – Information HUB
