ACCIDENT INFORMATION FOR PILOTS

Quick Reference Guide For Flight Crew Involved In Aeronautical Occurrences

**SNA RECOMMENDS THAT YOU MAKE NO STATEMENTS
UNTIL YOU TALK TO YOUR REPRESENTATIVE**

1. Carry out procedures for the preservation of lives, evidences and the aircraft or its wreckage;
2. Care for your individual needs, the crew and passengers;
3. Notify the authorities and you company (if applicable);
4. Contact SNA;
5. Do not make any statements to anyone, including family members;
6. Obtain, if possible, any and all flight information/documentation;
7. Make private notes of the events;
8. Cooperate with the investigation authorities involved in the investigation;
9. Respect the laws in which you are in.
