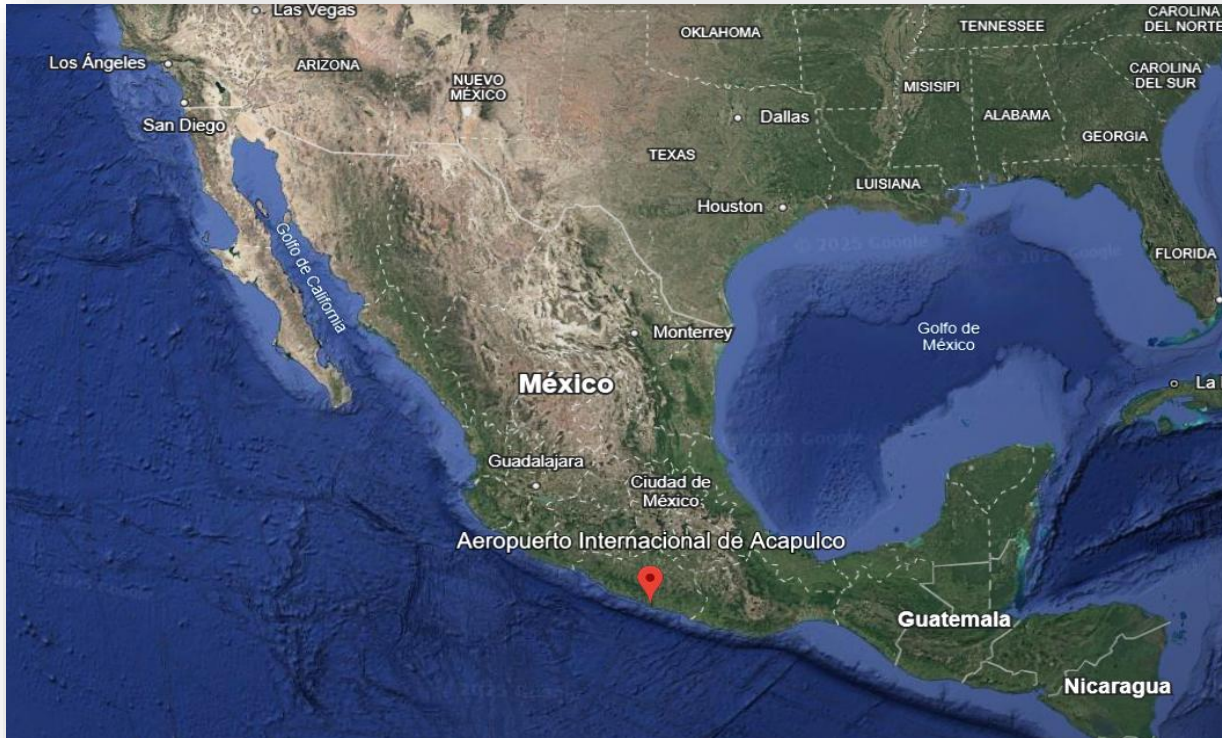
Aerodrome Emergency Operations and Recovery: the Acapulco Experience

Acapulco's visitors could arrive by land, sea and air, cause its, roadways, harbor, and airport.

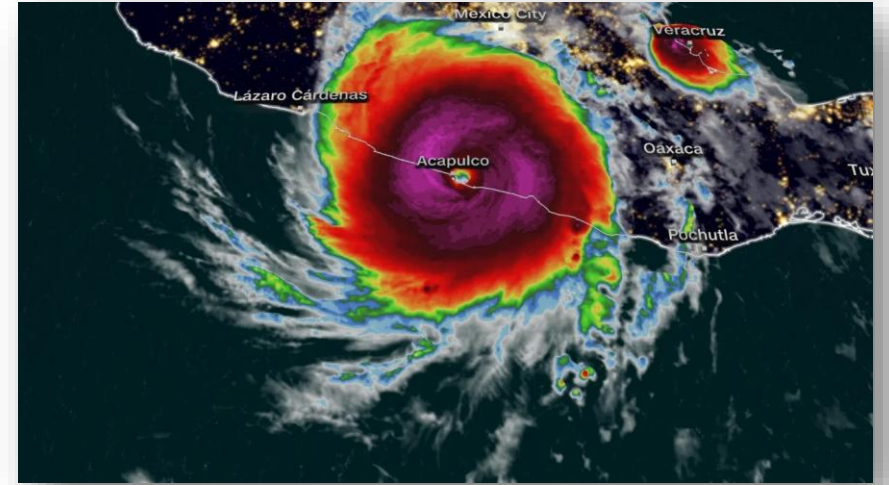


Aerodrome Emergency Operations and Recovery: the Acapulco Experience

The impact of OTIS in Acapulco caused several mayor damage all over the city, destroying big buildings but houses as well. Made a a flooding that last for a couple of days, so the emergency was not only the impact itself, it were lack of wáter, electricity, internet and phone lasting for weeks.

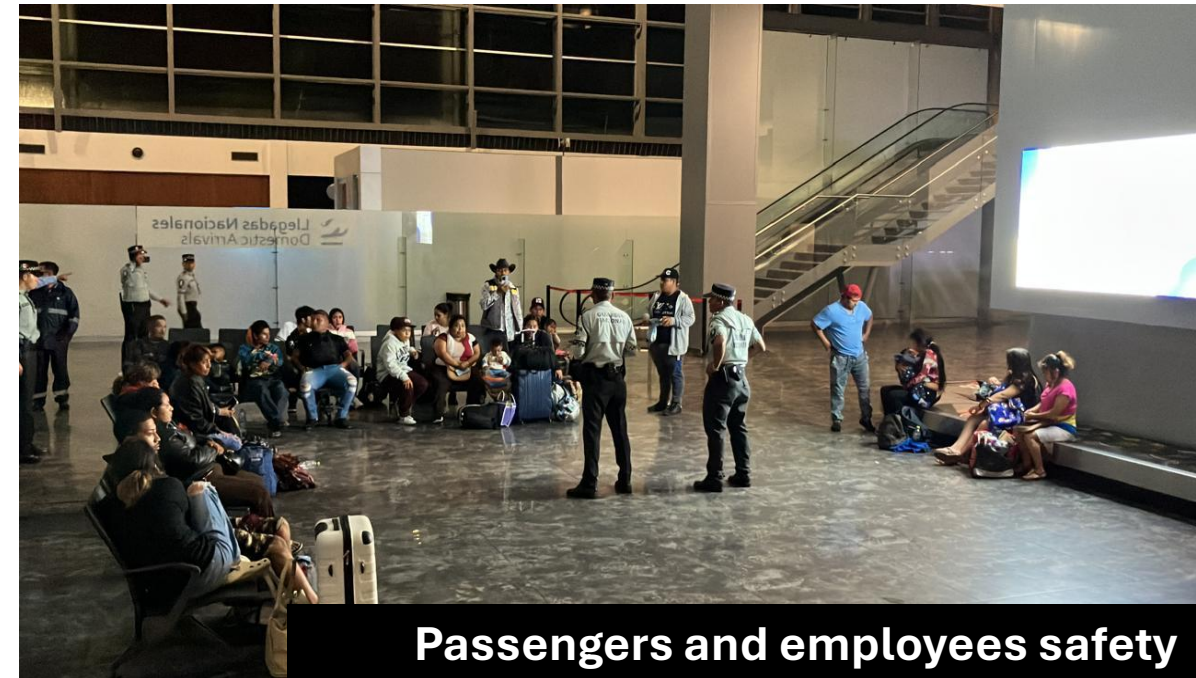

15 Oct NHC warned mid october 2023, about OTIS.

22 Oct OTIS becomes a Storm

- 24 Oct**
- Airport regular operations
 - Maintenance and security personnel Reinforcement
 - Food, water and Fuel stored for people and equipment.
 - Celebrate operational committee to inform the situation
 - Last Operations cancelled
 - OTIS become level 5 in less than 12 hours
